<sup>\*\*\*</sup>In the Events 41 and 42, the 8 fastest swimmers from Event 27 and 28 will compete against each other in an elimination heat. The team to swim is drawn directly before the start. The ratings in the KO final will not be considered in the team evaluation.



## **Awards and Recognitions**

## **Individual scoring**

In the 50m and 400 m individual events, all winners in each evaluation category (except knock-out finals) will receive medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

Record price: Swimmers who set a new event record in the open class in the individual competitions will receive a cash reward for the amount of 48 €.

The record price will only be awarded to the swimmer who has swum the fastest record time at the end of the event. There is no reward for a year group record. The previous records can be taken from the attachment.

**Best junior athlete** (2010 and younger, male): The athlete with the best points performance according to the FINA points table receives a

trophy and a "Saturn-voucher"; for the amount of 48 € at the final award ceremony.

**Best junior athlete** (2010 and younger, female): The athlete with the best points performance according to the FINA points table receives a

trophy and a "Saturn-voucher"; for the amount of 48 € at the final award ceremony.

The winners of the events 41 and 42 will each receive:

 $1^{st}$  place: 48 € and the **knock-out trophy of the VR Bank**,  $2^{nd}$  place: 38 €  $3^{rd}$  place: 28 €.

## **Team scoring**

The "Fördepokal of the Flensburger Schwimmklub von 1930 e. V." goes to the winner of the team scoring. This year is

the prize is endowed with 480 €.

The winner will be responsible for the engraving of the Förde-trophy and will bring it to next year's event. In case of non-participation in the following year the Förde-trophy has to be delivered to the Flensburger Schwimmklub in time.

**Scoring for the "Fördepokal"**: Only the best placed athlete of a club will be included in the scoring order for each event and scoring class. According to the ranking in this order, the first 7 swimmers (i.e. the club, if present in the ranking), will receive points (except the participants in the knock-out final). Score key for individual events 10-8-6-4-3-2-1. In relay events, points count double: 20-16-12-8-6-4-2.

The "Dr. Bronski Pokal" is awarded to the mixed relay teams of the 2010 and younger years as well as the 2009 and older years by adding the times of the mixed relay teams. Teams of the clubs that participate in both relay events in one evaluation category and finish them will be included in the scoring. Disqualified relay teams will not be included in the overall ranking. The winners are the teams with the fastest time.

## Mixed-Relay (2009 and older)

1<sup>st</sup> place : 75 € and **Relay-Trophy 2023**  $2^{nd}$  place: 50 € and  $3^{rd}$  place: 25 €.

## **Award ceremonies**

The award ceremonies will be held during the events. They are part of the events. Swimmers who do not attend the award ceremony lose their right to their award. At the final awards ceremony on Sunday, cash and non-cash prizes as well as trophies will be awarded.





## **General terms and conditions**

### 1. Legal regulations

The competition regulations (WB), the legislation (RO), the competition fee regulations (WGO) and the anti-doping regulations (ADO) of the German Swimming Association (Deutscher Schwimm-Verband e. V.; DSV) apply. For disabled persons with appropriate proof of classification, the competition regulations of the German Disabled Sports Association are additionally applied. All active members of clubs, departments and start communities affiliated to the DSV or FINA are eligible to participate. The event is announced to the SHSV and the DSV.

### 2. Licences and sports health

Together with the registration, the clubs have to provide an insurance, that the swimmers registered by them, have the right to start for the club, that the annual compulsory licence according to § 19 Abs. 2 WB-AT (for German clubs) has been paid and that they have proved their sport health by a medical certificate, which is not older than one year. The entry form may only be sent and accepted by the organizer without a signature and a binding declaration on sports health according to § 11 WB-AT if the entry form is submitted by data transmission according to DSV standard and sent by e-mail. In this case the signature must be made up before the start of the event or a signed registration form (DSV Form 101 Version 2012-03) must be handed in to the organizer. The club is not eligible to start without a signed registration form. The Flensburger Schwimmklub von 1930 e. V. is not liable if it turns out that a sports health or the valid annual license is not available.

### 3. Restrictions of the competition program

The eight- to ten-year-old swimmers are not allowed to compete in more than 6 events per day (including relay) (age groups 2013 and younger).

In the competitions 23 and 24 (1500 m freestyle) as well as 39 and 40 (800 m freestyle) the entries of the clubs should orient to the guide times. Cancellations for the events 23 and 24 must be submitted to the speaker by the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> part and for the events 39 and 40 by the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> part. Afterwards, the team leaders will discuss the execution of these events. These events and the events 25 and 26 (400m freestyle) might be carried out with double lane occupancy and manual timekeeping. The fastest run can again take place in single lane occupancy and with automatic time measurement.

In the third part of the meeting, one referee must be appointed per club for every 3 entries started, i. e. 1 referee for 1-3 entries, 2 referees for 4-6 entries, etc.

## 4. Knock-out-Final 41 and 42

In the knock-out competitions 41 and 42, the eight fastest swimmers from the events 27 and 28 will compete against each other in five elimination heats. The stroke in which the 50 m must be swam, will be drawn before the start. The number of swimmers is reduced according to the elimination method 8 - 6 - 4 - 3 - 2.

#### Swimwear

The FINA regulations and the corresponding DSV explanatory notes must be observed for swimwear. It should be noted that appropriate visual checks are carried out before the starts.

## 6. Start rule and time measurement

The one-start rule applies to all events. Electronic timing is used.

#### Judging panel

The number of referees to be provided by the participating clubs can be found in the meet program. For the 3<sup>rd</sup> part the general terms and the terms in the 3<sup>rd</sup> section regarding the referees have to be observed.

#### 8. Lane counter

The clubs are responsible for the operation of the obligatory lane counter panels at the freestyle events 800 m and 1500 m. This activity is not carried out by the turning referee.

#### 9. Other

Access to the hall is restricted to the athletes, their supervisors/trainers and the referees and is through the athletes'; entrance of the Campusbad. Glass bottles may not be brought along. Spectators are requested to take a seat in the gallery (entrance through the main entrance).

Only the sand/gravel-parking area in front of the Campusbad is available for the participants of the event.





#### 10. Registration and data protection

By submitting the registrations the club / the starting community accepts the tender and declares that it has received a data protection declaration from every person involved in the event (athletes, coaches, referees and helpers) - in the case of minors from their legal guardians - according to which the organizer and organizer are permitted to

- 1. collect, store, process and also in the context of reports about the event publish and forward to the SHSV as well as the DSV personal data of the above-mentioned group of persons relevant to the competition results, competition protocols and best lists, also electronically. The entry result, the protocol and the best lists will be published on the internet on the homepage of the organizer, the SHSV and the DSV.
- 2. publish personal data relevant to the competition as well as photos, film shots or photomechanical reproductions of the above-mentioned group of persons taken during the event and to forward them to the organiser, SHSV and DSV as well as third parties such as media, social networks and sponsors for use.
- 3. transmit the entire competition event via livestream to the internet, if necessary.

The above data include: Name, first name, sex, year of birth, performance achieved (placement, time achieved and points scoring), any disqualifications with reasons, club membership and, for judges, the position.

Entries must be made on the DSV registration form (DSV Form 101) and DSV registration list (DSV Form 102) stating the ID number of the active participant, the year of birth, the age group, the club ID and the code number of the respective national association. In the relay entries, the evaluation classes and the names of the relay swimmers must be indicated. The names of the relay swimmers can still be changed on the competition day, but the classification classes cannot. Notifications shall preferably be sent by e-mail using a file in accordance with the DSV 7 or LENEX standard, or by post.

With the registrations, the registering club acknowledges the terms of this tender as legally binding.
